What You'll Need:

- 1. Your address and your electric utility provider account number (account number is not required but recommended)
- 2. **Your latest Ting power quality report email** (you will be forwarding this email to your electric utility provider)
- 3. **A help or support contact email address** you can find this on your electric utility bill or online on your electric utility provider's website

Steps:
